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Campus Recognized Sorority and Fraternity Transparency Act

The Campus-Recognized Sorority and Fraternity Transparency Act ([Assembly Bill 524; Sections 66310-66312 of California Education Code](#)) requires each California institution of higher education to include in the institution's requirements for campus recognition of a campus-recognized sorority or fraternity, as defined, a requirement that the sorority or fraternity submit to the institution on or before July 1, 2023, and annually thereafter, specified information concerning the sorority's or fraternity's member's academics, service hours, addresses of the chapter homes, mental health services, sanctioned events and their conduct. The information in this report is shared annually in October with the Cal State LA community about the previous academic year.

The following report includes required information for fraternity and sorority organizations recognized at California State University, Los Angeles during the Fall 2025 to Spring 2026 academic Year.
